In the name of God Amen. I Alexander Murray of Southampton
county & parish of St Lukes, being in a low State of health, but of a
sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last will in manner
following. First and principally I recommend my Soul to almighty God
the Creator of all things & as for what worldly goods it hath been pleased
God to bless me with I dispose off in the following manner viz

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Harwood, one Negro girl named
Bess, to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elisabeth Smith one negro girl named
Ely to her & her heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Murray two negroes namely
Mary & Philip, One bed and furniture, one horse & saddle which said
Negroes and other Estate I give to her and her heirs for ever.

Item I lend to my wife during her life all the remainder of my estate.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Ely Smith after the death of my
wife one negro woman named Milly & thirty pounds current money, which
said negro and money I give to her and her heirs for ever.

I lend to my daughter Ely Smith the plantation whereon I now live
but if she should have an heir lawfully begotten, then I give the said
land to her & her heirs, but if my daughter Ely Smith should die with-
out an heir lawfully begotten, then I give & bequeath my aforesaid plan-
tation to my daughter Sarah Murray to her & her heirs for ever.

Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Murray after the death of my
wife two Negroes namely David & Mamey to her & her heirs for ever.

My will & desire is that all the residue of my Estate after the death of
my wife to be equally divided between my two daughters Mary Harwood
& Sarah Murray to them & their heirs for ever.

And lastly I constitute & appoint my wife & John Ammons my
whole and sole Executors and Executor to this my last will & testament
