In the name of God. I, Sarah Nicolson of the county of Southampton being of sound mind and memory do make & ordain this my last will and testament. By.
Impression
After my funeral Expenses are defrayed and just Debts paid I dispose of my worldly goods both real and personal which it hath pleased almighty God of his mercy & goodness to bestow on me in the following manner to wit:
Item I give to my grand daughter Sarah Myrick a gold ring
Item I give all my wearing apparell to be divided amongst my daughters and grand daughters & others of my family agreeable to an instrument of writing bearing date December 29th 1780 directing how to divide the same which is left with the will in the care of my Executors.
Item I direct that the instrument of writing mentioned in the clause next above, not to be revided.
Item I desire the remainder part of my Estate in whatsoever manner it lieth or may be found, may be sold to the highest bidder & the money arising from the sale thereof to be equally divided between my children & grand children hereafter mentioned (taking notice what of my grandchildren are children of any one of my children) to have but one equal part divided betwixt them) to wit: My daughter Elisabeth Nicolson, my daughter Fanny Myrick & my grand daughters Fanny Nicolson, Lucy Nicolson & Matilda Nicolson (daughter of Joshua Nicolson dead) one equal part to be divided betwixt them And my Grandson Edwin Perward & grand daughter Sarah Briggs Thors one equal part to be divided betwixt them. And my grand daughters Sarah Edmunds & Lucy Edmunds, Daughters of my Daughter Lucy Edmunds dead) one equal part to be divided between them as above.
