he has pleased to bless me with I give & bequeath them as follows.
First I desire all my just Debts & funeral Expences to be paid and
satisfied.

I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Sarah Oney all my Estate both
real and personal during her natural life.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Gay five shillings

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Martha King five shillings

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Needison five shillings

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy Martin five shillings

I give and bequeath & it is my will that after the death of my
wife that all the Estate I have given her may be equally divided
between my two youngest daughters Elisabeth & Rebecca Oney, ex-
cept what I have given my four daughters that are married. And
lastly I do appoint my loving wife Sarah Oney Executrix of this
my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I have set my
hand and seal this seventeenth day of March One thousand seven
hundred and Eighty four.
