

All a court held for the county of Southampton the 11th day of Nov^r. 1784. This will was presented in court by John Rich & Pilgrimage both two of the Executors therein named and proved by the oaths of John Jackson & Thomas Rich two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executors who made oath affirmations (being of the people called Quakers) according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon etc.

Friday 22 October 1784.

Jacob Turner Will.
I have Memorandum of Jacob Turner's desire of the management of his Estate after his death. That is for his wife to live on his whole Estate during her life and for no Reimbursements to be made of any thing except it is seen wasting untill his son James comes of age, and then for him to have a Horse purchased out of the Estate of as much value as his son John Turners horse was of and after that and the death of his wife for an equal division to be made of all that was left amongst all his children.

1784. October 25th John Purcell, Holland Turner & Jacob Turner came before me & was sworn upon the evangelists of almighty God & the deponents with that Jacob Turner senior was in his perfect senses & left his Estate as above written but did not assign.

This writing purporting the disposition of the personal Estate of Jacob Turner deceased, was proved by the oaths of John Purcell & Jacob Turner jun^r: two of the witnesses thereto who put the same in writing at the request of the testator and was ordered to be recorded.

John Summrell Will.

In the name of God. I, John Summrell of the county of Southampton being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following viz.
I give and bequeath unto my Son John Summrell a new City of land lying on the west side of the road next to my houses containing fifty seven acres to him my said son John & his heirs forever.
