Southampton being sick of body but of perfect mind and memory  
do make this as for my last will and testament.

First I give and bequeath to my Son Daniel a tract or parcel of land  
bearing a line from a corner tree of Samuel Story's standing in the  
field of his meadows through my land unto a corner tree of George  
Curly's line to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son James all the remainder part of  
my land to him and his heirs for ever. I furthermore desire that  
all the remainder of my Estate of whatever kind it shall be to  
the use of my wife and my son James and after my wife's death  
my son James to enjoy the whole of my Estate that then remaining.

Item I give unto my Son Lewis Story, also John Story also Nehah Story  
also Nandy Story, also Sally Story also Elisabeth Story & Samuel Story  
I furthermore desire that my Son Daniel Story should execute this  
as and for my last will and testament.
