I furthermore desire that all the remainder of my Estate of whatever kind it be shall be to the use of my wife and my son James and after my wife's death my son James to enjoy the whole of my Estate that then remaining.

I give unto my Son Lewis Story, also John Story also Selah Story also Nandy Story, also Sally Story also Elizabeth Story & Samuel Story I furthermore desire that my Son Daniel Story should execute this as and for my last will and testament.
