I give and bequeath unto my son Edmund Bailey one hundred acres of land more
or less in Vpper county where he now lives on the North side of New rock bounded
by lines made formerly to him and his heirs for ever.

I give and bequeath unto my son Abidan Bailey one hundred and fifty acres
of land more or less on the south side of Seniock Swamp in Sussex county commonly
called Crooks bounded by lines made and agreed to formerly to him and his
heirs for ever.

I give unto friend Davis the plantation whereon he now lives with forty acres
of land more or less bounded with lines already made and agreed to to him and
his heirs for ever.

I lend the use of my plantation whereon I now live with two hundred and
twenty five acres of land to my dear and well beloved wife Sarah during
her natural life and after her death I give the said land and plantation
to Edmund Bailey and Abidan Bailey and Miriam Hargrave to them
and their heirs equally to be divided. I give to my wife Sarah One feather
bed and furniture, two Cows & calves, one safe, half a dozen chairs, three pewter
dishes, and nine pewter plates two basons one iron pot and one iron pan, three
Cows and lambs, two fowls & pigs, one horse and side saddle and bridle, one chest,
two gilt trunks half a dozen knives and forks, one iron pot rack, one iron
mortar and pestle, one cotton spinning wheel and two pair cards, one washing
tub, one pair one piggin one axe, one hoe, one stone jug, half a dozen bottles
ten barrels of corn. I lend the use of my still and copper kettle to my wife
during her life also all the earthen ware.

I give Elijah Bailey one feather bed and furniture. I give to my Son
Joshua Bailey one feather bed & furniture, one hand mill and after my
wife's death I give my still and worm to Mourning Russell and Rhoda
Tadler. I give to my Son Abalom Bailey all my wearing clothes I give
to my daughter Sarah Brock after my wife's death my copper kettle. The
remainder and residue of my Estate I leave to be sold and the money to be
equally divided between my four daughters Miriam Hargrave, Sarah
Brock, Mourning Russell and Rhoda Tadler. I nominate and appoint
my sons Abidan Bailey and Joshua Bailey Executors of this my last
will and testament as witnesses my hand and seal this 18th day of
April 1784.
