 twenty one years, then I give the land that I have given to Eliza unto my

 all that my sons Eliza and Henry should both die before either of them
 arrives to the age of twenty one years then I give all my lands to my son
 Benjamin and to his heirs for ever.

I do appoint my friend Benjamin Blunt whole & sole Executor of
 his my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my seal this first day of August 1786.
