

In Obedience to an Order of the worshipful Court of Southampton
we have obtained all the Estate of Wmth DeLoach presented to our View

Braz. Guin ^{mark} Summerville

A Court held for the county of Southampton the 10th day of March
1785. This Inventory & appraisement of the Estate of Wmth DeLoach
decd. was returned & ordered to be recorded.

In the name of God. I, Charity Johnson of Southampton
county being sick and weak of body but of sound & disposing mind and
memory thanks be to almighty God for the same, but calling to mind the
uncertainty of this life and knowing that it is appointed once for all
people to die, do make and ordain this my last will & testament in
manner & form following. First & principally I recommend my Soul
into the hands of Almighty God who gave it, and my body to the
ground from whence it was taken, hoping at the last day to receive
that joyful sentence, come ye blessed children of my father inherit the
kingdom prepared for you from the beginning. And as for what
worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I give and
bequeath in manner following. Item I give and bequeath unto my
daughter Betty Johnson, One Negro girl called Violet & her increase
one feather bed & furniture (now called her own) one wool wheel &
best pair cotton cards, one Loom & the Gear that belongs to the same
and one dark brindled heifer (now branded) also one pair iron rods
to her & her heirs & assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Elias Johnson One Negro Boy
named Davy, one feather bed & furniture, and one reddish colored
heifer with a white face to him & his heirs & assigns for ever.

Item It is my will and desire that after all my just debts are
paid the remainder of my personal Estate (that is not before
devised be equally divided between the survivors of my children
to them their heirs & assigns for ever.

Lastly. I appoint my friend Josiah Piche my whole & sole Exor
of this my last will & testament revoking and disannulling all
former will or wills by me hitherto made & allowing this and
no other to be my last will & testament. In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the 3^d day of May
1785.
