I give to my beloved wife Mary and her heirs for ever my coffee kettle, coffee mill, spice mortar, all my cyder barrels, all my cow hides & all my cotton & wool together with my loom.

After my just debts and funeral expenses are paid I give & bequeath all the rest of my Estate to be equally divided betwixt my two daughters Mary Cobb and Anne Satter to them & their heirs for ever.

Item

I constitute and appoint my son in law John Cobb & my grandsons Quon Cobb to execute this my last will & testament, and do hereby revoke & disannul all and every will & testament by me heretofore made ratifying & confirming this and no other, to be my once last will & testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this nineteenth day of March one thousand seven hundred & eighty five.
