

live with one hundred and ninety eight acres of land thereto adjoining, lying on the north side the Shavering Bridge branch, bounded as followeth, by the said branch, thence to Dolphin Run's lone, thence to the Angelica Swamp, thence up the swamp to the beginning at the mouth of the said branch. I also lend to my said wife the use of my Mill, untill my son James Drown arrives to the age of twenty one years, then I lend her the use of only the one half of my said mill during her natural life. Likewise lend my wife the use of the remainder of my Estate after paying all my just debts during her natural life to raise and educate my children on untill they come of age or marry, then to receive their legacies hereafter mentioned as above directed.

Item I give and devise to my son Nedit Drown one hundred acres of land lying in the forks of the Shavering bridge branch and Parrell's branch to Abraham Johnson's lone Likewise bequeath to my said son, Nedit one hundred and ninety eight acres of land that I lent my wife after her death to him and his heirs. Also give to my son Nedit one negro boy called Ben together with one horse bridle and saddle and a feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs.

Item I give and devise to my son James Drown all my lands lying on the head of Parrell's branch in the fork of said branch and the fork branch, also the remaining half of my mill when he arrives to the age of twenty one, & the other half after the death of my wife, with four acres of land adjoining two acres of which my father left me, on the south end the dam, and the other two on the north end to him and his heirs. Likewise give to my son James one Negro called Mingo, one Horse saddle and bridle, and one feather bed & furniture.

Item I give to my daughter Susanna Drown one Negro called Nat and one feather bed & furniture.

Item I give to my daughter Mary Drown one Negro called Young Harry, also one feather bed & furniture.

Item I give to my daughter Sarah Drown one negro woman called Sall and her increase also one feather bed & furniture.

Item I give to my daughter Piscilla Drown two Negroes called Bob, the other Pompey also one feather bed & furniture.

Item I give and bequeath to my above mentioned children their said legacies to them and their heirs.

Item My will & desire further is that the remainder of my Estate of every kind or nature whatsoever of wheresoever found after the death of my wife be equally divided between my surviving children and their increase.

I do appoint my loving wife Mary Drown and my trusty friends Wm Myrick and Randolph Nendorn sole Executors to this my last will & testament. In Witness whereof I the said Jeremiah Drown
