do make ordain, constitute & appoint this to be my last will & testament
in manner & form following.

My Soul I recommend to the mercy of God who gave it to me & as to my worldly goods I give them as follows

The whole of my Estate both real & personal I give to my wife Martha Clements as long as she remains unmarried but in case of marriage I desire an equal Division of my Estate should be made immediately by my Executors between my wife Martha Clements & my daughter Sally Williamson Clements, except my household & kitchen furniture which I give to my wife & after her death it is my will & desire my Estate devised to my said wife shall revert to my daughter Sarah Williamson Clements.

I desire there may be no appraisement of my Estate.

I nominate and appoint Col. Tho: Williamson, Mr. William Urquhart,
Col. John Hartwell Cocke, and Mr. Hartwell Cocke, Executors to this
my last will & testament, hereby revoking and annulling all former wills
& testaments by me made. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and affixed my seal this 19th day of July Anno Domini 1764.
