In the name of God. Amen. I Nathan Harris being in my perfect
 mind and memory do make this my last will & testament in manner and
 form as followeth (to wit.)
 I lend to my loving wife Mary Harris the use of my whole Estate during her
 natural life or widowhood, or untill the time that my son Nerdit Harris
 arrive to the age of twenty one years, and in case my wife should marry
 then I lend her the use of the land and plantation wherons I now live during
 her natural life, and at the time of my wifes marriage if she does not
 marry, at the time my son Nerdit arrives to the age of twenty one years
 I desire that all my slaves should be equally divided betwix my wifes
 and all my children that shall then be living, and the slaves so divided
 in a child's part I also lend her during her natural life.
 I give and bequeath to my son Nerdit Harris to be possessed with
 at his mothers death all this land or parcel of lands wherons I now live
 to him and his heirs for ever.
 I desire that if my son Nerdit Harris should die before he arrives
 to the age of twenty one years or without lawful issue that the land I have
 given
