

given him may be at my wife's death or (if he should die before) at the time my son Newt would have arrived to the age of twenty one years, sold by my executors hereafter to be mentioned, and the money arising from the sale thereof to be equally divided between my sons John, Edwin & Richard and if my wife should be pregnant with a male child I give the aforesaid money to be equally divided between my sons John, Edwin, Richard and the one not yet born to them and to their heirs for ever.

Item I give to my six children now in being namely, Newt, John, Edwin, Charlotte, Nancy & Richard Harris and also to the child that my wife is now pregnant with all my slaves except such as I have lent my wife during her natural life to be at the time my son Newt arrives to the age of twenty one years equally divided between them or the survivors of them to them and to their heirs for ever.

Item I give to my six children now in being namely Newt, John, Edwin, Nancy, Charlotte and Richard, and to the child that my wife is now pregnant with all the slaves that I have lent my wife during her life to be at her death equally divided between them or the survivors of them to them and to their heirs for ever.

Item I desire that all that tract of land I purchased of my brother John's Estate known by the name of the old place may at the time my son Newt arrives to the age of twenty one years to be sold by my executors hereafter to be mentioned and the money arising from the sale thereof I give to be equally divided between my sons John, Edwin, Richard and in case my wife should be pregnant with a male child then I give the aforesaid money to be equally divided between my sons John, Edwin, Richard & the one not yet born to them and their heirs for ever.

I desire that in case of the death of either of my sons John, Edwin, Richard and the one not yet born before they arrive to the age of twenty one years or without lawful issue that the money which may arise from the sale of the aforesaid tract of land and likewise from the sale of the land wherein I now live in case of the death of my son Newt may be equally divided between the survivors of them to them and to their heirs for ever.

Item I desire that if any of my children Newt, John, Edwin, Richard, Nancy, Charlotte & the one that my wife is pregnant with should before they arrive to the age of twenty one years or die without lawful
