Item I leave unto my beloved wife Fanny during her natural life the use of my plantation whereon I live and after her decease I give and devise the said plantation and all the remainder part of my land unto my son John Myrick to him his heirs and assigns forever

Item I give unto my Son Henry Myrick a riding horse Saddle & Bridle ten head of Cattle four Sows and Pigs and a Feather bed & Furniture

Item I give unto my Son Owen Myrick a horse Saddle and Bridle ten head of Cattle four Sows and Pigs and a Feather Bed & Furniture

Item I give unto my Son John Myrick a Horse Saddle and Bridle ten head of Cattle four sows and Pigs and a feather bed and Furniture

Item I give unto my Daughter Sarah Myrick a Horse saddle and Bridle and a feather bed and Furniture

Item I give unto my Daughter Nancy a Horse Saddle and bridle and a feather Bed and Furniture

Item I give unto my Daughter Fanny a horse Saddle and bridle and a feather Bed and Furniture

Item I give unto my Daughter Lucy a Horse Saddle and Bridle and a feather Bed and Furniture

Item I leave unto my wife Fanny the use of all my Slaves Stock of Hens Cattle Sheep and hogs together with all my household and kitchen furniture & plantation Utensils until my Son Henry arrives at the age of Twenty one Year at which time my will and desire is that all my Slaves with their Increase may be divided into eight equal parties four honest decentest to me chose and appointed by the worshipful Court of Hampton and when so divided for my wife Fanny to have the privilege of Taking her choice of one of the eight parties for her use during life and the other seven parties I give unto my seven children Sarah Henry Nancy Fanny Owen Lucy and John Myrick each part or lot to be Drawn for and Confirmed by a fair impartial Lottery
