A Court held for the county of Southampton the 7th day of Sept^r 1785
This Will was presented in Court by Richard Wren the executor therein named Susanah Thorpe the executrix & failing proved by the oath of William Wren one of the witnesses thereto and ordered continued for further proof & on the motion of the said executor who made affirmation according to law being one of the people called Quakers Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form giving security whereupon &c
And at a Court held for the said County of Southampton the 2nd day of March 1786 This will was further proved by the oath of Charles Briggs another witness thereto and ordered to be recorded
