In the Name of God Amen I Richard Blaw of St. Lukes Parish in the County of Southampton being in a low State of Health the of sound and perfect Sense and Memory, do hereby make Constitutes and Orders this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows

I Give and bequeath unto my loving wife Ann Blaw three Negroes to wit a Fellow called Scipis and two others by the name of Moriah and Humal which two were left her in Thomas Blenters Will also one Bed and Furniture and the best horse I dispossessed of the Choice to the rest with herself

I Give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Blaw one Negro Boy Called Brofes to him and his heirs forever

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin Blaw a Negro boy Called James to him and his heirs forever

I Give and bequeath unto my Son James Blaw one Negro Boy Called Philleb to him and his heirs forever

I Give and bequeath unto my Son Peter Blaw a Negro Boy Called Darcy to him and his heirs forever

I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Blaw one Negro Girl Called Rachel to her and her heirs forever

I desire that the residue of my estate both real and personal may be sold for the purpose of Paying all my Just debts should there be Ballance remaining I request of my Executors hereafter named to divide it equally between my five children Thomas, Benjamin, James, Peter and Ann Blaw I do hereby Constitute and Appoint my friends John Thomas Blaw Esq^r William Thomas and Thomas Vaughan Executors to this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this nineteenth day of December in the year four Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and eighty five
