Will and Testament in manner and form as follows Vizt  
I give and bequeath unto my living wife Ann Blow three Negroes to  
wit a Fellow called Scipio and two others by the names of Moreah and Hannah  
which two were left to me Thomas Blew will also one Bed and Furniture  
and the best horse I disposed of of the choice to the rest with herself  
Item I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Blow and Negro Boy called  
Onofe to him and his heirs forever  
Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin Blow a Negro boy called James  
to him and his heirs forever  
Item I give and bequeath unto my Son James Blow one negro Boy called  
Philip to him and his heirs forever  
Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Peter Blow a Negro Boy Called  
Davy to him and his heirs forever  
Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Blow and Negro  
girl called Rachel to her and her heirs forever  
I desire that the Residue of my estate both real and personal may be  
sold for the purpose of Paying all my just debts should there be  
a Ballance remaining I request of my Executors here after named  
to divide it equally between my five children Thomas, Benjamin,  
James, Peter and Ann Blow I do hereby Constitute and  
Appoint my friends John Thomas Blew Fint. William Thomas and Thomas  
Vaughan Esqrs to this my last Will and Testament In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this  
nineteenth day of December in the year four thousand one thousand  
Seven Hundred and eighty five —
