In the Name of God Amen I Abirden Jones of the County of Southampton Esq. of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last will and Testament in writing and declare the writing as and for my last will and Testament in writing

First I give devise and bequeath unto my son Matthew Jones the following tract or parcels of Land (to wit) Eight hundred and fifty acres purchased by me of Charles Rivers on the fork of Blackwater and Holloway Rivers three hundred and eighty seven acres purchased of Robert Rivers called the cedar Island and situated in the County of Warrimour To hold the said Lands with their appurtenances unto my said son and his heirs and assigns forever also Twenty acres of land called up and surveyed by me in the said County and Town of Tabor Island To him and his heirs forever I also give and bequeath unto my said son Matthew Jones all the Slaves that I have already possessed him with to wit Ned Isaac Roger James Peter with the increase of the two above mentioned vessels with all Stock of Goods cattle sheep and Hogs to him and his heirs forever

I give devise and bequeath to my son William Jones the following Tracts or parcels of Land (to wit) One hundred acres purchased of Thomas Holt and Ann his wife and since purchased of John Wilbraun of his Sons called Bryants Quarter two hundred acres purchased by Richard Williams adjoining thereto Eighty acres lying between the upper end of the Sacuridge and Jesse Johnsons land which was granted to me by patent and seventy five acres purchased of Isaac cloth Perrell to hold the said Lands with their appurtenances to my said son William his heirs and assigns forever I also give and bequeath to my said son William this Negro Woman I purchased of the Estate of Richard Kirker called Amy or all the present issue and future increase that belongs to me also my two Negro men called Toney and Pompey and Negro Boy named Dancy to him and his heirs forever

I give devise and bequeath to my son Abirden Jones all the rest of my Lands not hitherto bequeathed my water Court Mills and all the Buildings Orchards Gardens and appurtenances thereto belonging to the whole to him and his heirs forever and it is my will and desire that if either of my two Sons Abirden or William should Decease this life before they arrived to the age of Twenty and so making legal Disposition of the said Lands in favor of that then such Lands and signant may given unto the surviving Brother or his representatives forever My Intention in foregoing Devices is that in case my said Son
