 to each of them be looked upon as a fee simple Estate being only intended  
 to be limited in case of the Death of either of them and as if without there  
 suspending of such Lands I also give unto my son Albington all and every  
 one of my Slaves not heretofore bequeathed to him who's heirs forever  
 as to my Married Children I have given them already the part of my  
 estate intended for them therefore shall make no further mention of  
 them

I Give Give and bequeath to my son Albington Jones all the rest  
 and Remainder of my Estate he paying my Just debts and I do hereby  
 appoint my son Albington my whole and full Executor of this my  
 last Will and Testament in Testimony whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and affix my seal this Twentieth second day of September  
 one Thousand seven hundred and Eighty four

 possess a negro Girl my property named Leticia and I do hereby  
 give and bequeath to the said Ann Simmons the said Negro Girl  
 named Leticia to her and her heirs and I do further declare in my  
 will and desire that my son Albington Jones whom I have  
 before named and constituted Executor of this my last will and  
 Testament should be also the guardian of my son William Jones  
 witness my hand and seal this Twelfth Day of December 1835
