

196 and his heirs forever notwithstanding if he should die under the age of twenty one years or without lawful issue then the said Negro boy to be conveyed into slavery amongst my children hereafter named and I also give him one bed and furniture

Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Mandell one Negro Girl called Beland her in case if any to her and her heirs forever and I give her one feather bed and furniture that is now called hers

Item I give to Hannah Ellis five shillings wife of Sam^r Ellis

Item I give to my Daughter Lidia Mandell one Negro Girl called Selvy her in case if any to her and her heirs forever and I give her one feather bed and furniture

Item I give to my Daughter Mary Mandell one Negro Girl called Selvy and her in case if any to her and her heirs forever and I give her one feather bed and furniture

Item I give to my Son William Mandell two Negroes Jerry and Sam with the increase if any to him and his heirs forever and I give him one feather bed and furniture

My will and desire is that if any of my children under age shall die poor without lawful issue then his or their parts to be divided between the others Elizabeth John Joseph Lidia Mary and William or as many of them as is living at the time of the death of him or them

My will and desire is that my son Joseph may have one year's schooling my Daughter Lidia and my Daughter Mary two and my Son William three years to be paid for out of the use of my Estate not yet devised

Item I lend to my wife Elizabeth Mandell the use of all the remaining part of my Estate not before bequeathed during her natural life or widowhood only she shall maintain and pay for the schooling of the above mentioned children and paying my debts if any but at her death or if she should marry them the whole of the Estate but to be taken and sold and Equally divided amongst my six children here named Elizabeth John Joseph Lidia Mary and William or as many of them as shall be living at the time

My will and desire is that after the death of Sarah Harris the Negroes that she holds by jointure maid her by John Scott during her natural life and after her death second to me and equally divided amongst my six children above named or as many of them as shall be living at that time to them and their heirs forever

My will and desire is that my wife Elizabeth Mandell should have the use of my Hammer plantation during her natural life or widowhood
