Item after the death or marriage of my wife it is my will and desire that the rest of my estate as is not given as above shall be equally divided between my son Thomas Mountfort and Francis Mountfort my Daughter.

Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute ordain and appoint my loving wife Sarah & thenceforth my Brother Wm. Mauntfortt and my esteemed friend David Barrow my whole and sole Executors and Executor of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have here set my hand and Seal this tenth day of March in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven signed Sealed pronounced declared by the said Thomas Mauntfortt as his last will and Testament in presence
