Item I give unto my son Arthur Washington and his heirs forever two
hundred and thirty acres land being the fourth part of the land given
me by the will of my Father and found on a survey made by
Daniel Fisher and laid off by a line dividing my son James part
and the old bounds of my Father land by a pole field branch further
give unto my son Arthur that part of my land by a line to be
run straight from a white oak alvine tree near the head of the
top branch to a red oak alvine tree standing on the side toward
hill road leaving the other part the land given my son Arthur
containing acres more or less

Item I give unto my son Amos Washington and his heirs forever all the remain-
ing part of land that descended to me from my Brother Thomas
Washington dec. not before disposed of my son Arthur.

Item I give unto my son James Washington the following Negroes Coll.
James Jacob I further give my said son fifty pounds current money

Item I give unto my son Arthur Washington the following Negroes, Botsman
Levy & Adam I further give my son one hundred pounds current
money

Item I give unto my son Amos Washington the following Negroes Jenny
Charlott and will I further give my said son fifty pounds current money

Item I give unto my Daughter Olive Washington fifty pounds
current money

Item my will and desire is that after my just debts and Legacies are
paid the remainder of my estate of what nature soever be equal-
ly divided amongst my four children James Arthur Amos &
Olive Washington

Lastly I do hereby appoint my friends Joseph Washington and
James Gray my whole and sole executors of this my last will
and Testament & wishing all other wills here to fore by me made
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
the 10 day Sept. 1770
