In the name of God Amen I Thomas Williamson of the
parish of Tottenham and County of Southampton the at this time
weak and infirm yet of sound mind do make and constitute this
writing as and for my last will and Testament hereby hereby revoking
all former wills or writings hereto fore by me made.

First I recommend my Soul to almighty God fully trust-
ing by the mediation of the universal Saviour that it will be receiv-
ed into the Mansions of our lasting Blessing my mortal body must
be committed to the Ground in such sort as my Executors in their
discretion shall direct my worldly possessions with which God hath
blessed my Industry I give and dispose of as hereafter particularly
mentioned

I Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Clements the care of the house
and plantation where once I formerly lived distinguished from my other
lands by the appellation of the old place containing eight hundred and
fifty acres more or less with the appertinances therunto belonging with
the household and kitchen furniture implements of husbandry there
also one still cup and warm and still tub two fags and therewithone
third part of the oxen cubs twenty cattle on an average of them
such all the hogs usually fed by Lewis and Jamez with these
following nineteen Slaves viz. Ester, Dick, Tompe, Essex George
David, Harry, Beck, Obed, Sam. honey, Del, Tom, Jamez, Fortune
Tom, Jenkins, Aggy, Lewis, John and Didon with their future
Increase from the date of these presents I give the use of all the above
to my said Daughter Elizabeth during her natural life and after her
decease I give the whole to my Grandson John Clements to him
and his heirs forever. I also give to my said Daughter the interest
of four thousand pounds in the government Funds during her
life and at her Death I give the interest of the above money
