and Interest to be disposed by them to their heirs in said proportion
they by their wills respectively may direct and in case of the death
of my Grand daughter Sarah Anne without issue give her part to my
said Daughter Elizabeth Clements. In case any of the above legons
should prove defective or incorrigible I leave my Executors in full power
to sell of them placing the moneys at Interest in good security and the
Interest shall be annually paid to my Daughter Elizabeth Clements
for her own proper use and at her Death I give the same sum to my
Daughters Children in such manner and proportion as she may direct
I give to my Daughter Sarah Taylor my Land and Plantation in
Northampton County North Carolina purchased of Anthony Thornton
with the slaves Black and complements thereon to her and her heirs
forever. All the remainder of my Estate real personal or mixed
not heretofore or hereafter devised I give to my Daughter Sarah
Taylor and to her Husband John Taylor together with them and their
heirs forever.
I give to Thomas Turner of the parish of St. Andrew's County of
Southampton the plantation whereon he lives containing one
hundred acres more or less.

In case it should so happen that government should pay off the
principal money in their Loan. Then I Desire my Executors to
place the above mentioned money in the hands of individuals
on good security for the purpose above intended. Lastly I
name and appoint my Son in Law John Taylor Esq.
my Friend William Vergahart and my Grandson John Clements
when he arrives to lawful age Executors of this my last will
and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my Seal this 24th Day of June 1774.
