 namely Lucy and Jack which she has now in her possession which
 said Negroes with their Increase I give to her and her heirs forever also
 give to my Daughter Martha Judkins my Chest my Drawers and a new small
 seal skin Trunk with every thing that is in them to her and her heirs forever
 I Give and bequeath to my Son Henry Westbrooke all the remainder of my
 estate of what kind or nature so ever or where so ever found which estate
 I give to my Son Henry to him and his heirs forever
 and Lastly I do appoint my son Henry Westbrooke my sole and Select
 Executor to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other Wills by
 me heretofore made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and Seal this sixteenth day of March 1786
