I Give and bequeath to far Fredrick Holt my Negro Man Harry to him & his heirs for ever my will is that my Negroes Roger Archer Peter & Harry be sold and the money arising from the said Negroes to be equally divided amongst between all my Children except my Daughter Amy & also all the Remaining part of my Estate to be sold and the money to be equally divided between all my Children or their heirs except my Daughter Amy my Will is that if a Bond that I was Security to Barrel Bell should ever come against my Estate that the money may be made out of that part of my Estate that I gave to my son Thomas Holt my Will is that my Estate be not appraised lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Thomas Holt my whole and Sole Executor of this my Last will and Testament Revoking all others Wills by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twenty Ninth day of Decem ber 1786 —
