of the parish of Saint Lukes in the County of Southampton being in sound
 sense and Memory do make and constitute this my last will and testament in
 manner and form following

I Give my son John the plantation and land whereon he now lives also one Negro
 Boy known by the name of Bob that he has now in his possession like wise two
 Cows and Calves All the household and kitchen furniture he has now in possession
 to him and his heirs forever

I Give unto my son Henry one Negro Girl known by the name of Tall that he
 has now in possession to him and his heirs forever also two Cows and calves

I Give unto my Daughter Elizabeth two Cows and calves

I Give unto my Son William my plantation and all my lands I now possess
 adjoining the same to him and his heirs forever also I give unto my son Wm
 my still also one Negro Man known by the name of Jimmy to him and
 his heirs forever

My Will and Desire is that if my Son William should die before he arrives
 to the age of twenty one years or lawful Issue of his body that the land
 and Negro I give him should be sold and the money arising from such
 Sale be equally divided Between all my Children then living

I Give unto my Son William one white mare Horse also one Bay Filly
 to him and his heirs forever also one Saddle and Bridle likewise
 two Cows and Calves two Swine and piggins Ten Shirts Twenty yards of
