In the name of God Amen Elizabeth

Daughtrey of Southampton county and state of Virginia being weak in body at present but of sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be to almighty God for the same and calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing it is appointed for all to die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament Viz: first of all I desire That all my debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged

Now I give to my beloved friend James Gardner just. all my cash either in hand or due me by any ways or means as that is due for my part of In: Daughtreys estate from David Wright and a bond from William Sallough to In: Daughtrey for three pounds eight shillings and one from David Edwards to John Daughtrey for four pounds sixteen shillings and one half of all my estate (exclusive of clothes) be it of any kind or quality whatsoever to him and his heirs

Item I give to my friend Peter Hines provided he continues at the place called Littletown where he now lives the residue of my estate exclusive of clothes i.e. one half but if he should remove his residence from the above mentioned place I give the same to my friend James Gardner just. to him his heirs &c

Now I give to my friend Elizabeth Elizabeth Boyt all my clothes and wearing apparel if she continues where she now lives but if she should remove her residence I give her one half of the said clothes and wearing apparel and the other half I give to my Sister Mary Wright

Lastly I nominate and appoint my trusty and well beloved friend James Gardner just. my whole and sole executor of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said Elizabeth Daughtrey have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 25th day of May 1785
