be according to law after my Death

sum of thirty pounds Current money of Virginia to be raised and loved
out of my Estate

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Son Charles Stephenson the sum of Six pounds
Current Money of Virginia

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Stephen Stephenson the sum of Six
pounds Current money of Virginia

Item I Give unto the Child my wife is now pregnant with the sum of thirty
pounds Current money of Virginia

Item I Give and bequeath unto ^{my} moving wife Mary Stephenson one horse breast
and that one which may be my said wifes choice together with two cows &
calves and Two Ewes and lambs which shall be her choice out of my
stock also to her own Disposal

Item the Remainder of my estate let it be of what nature or kind so ever
after my ~~Just~~ Debts and legacies are paid I give to be equally divided
Between my wife Mary Stephenson and the whole of my Children
namely Charles, Elizabeth, Edmund, Stephen Thomas, Robert,
Willis, Charlotte and John Stephenson and the child my wife
is now pregnant with But if in case such child should not
survive I Give such Legacy of £30 pounds before
