 I for the many good acts and causes of acts done one by my friend John Charles do hereby give unto him the said John Charles one acre of land to him and his heirs forever to be laid off by my Executors hereafter named to begin at the run of gravelly run just below the said John Charles fish pond and to run from there along Chadam to the end then round the end of the said dam to the said gravelly run
 It is my will and desire that my Nigromaw Mingo and all my other estate whatever should be sold and after my debts are discharged and Legacies paid of that the remainder I give to my son in law Charles Council and my son Phadrack Warrel my whole and sole Executors to this my last will and testament hereby ratifying and confirming the same and no other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this nineteenth day of September 1788
