I give

and bequeath unto my Son Simmons Vick the land and its appurtenances that may be above a line to be drawn by executors herein after named begining where the foot of the three Cypress Bridge now stands and running from thence such a course to the back of my line in the hog flash as will in their Judgment be the one half of the Tract whereon I now live, to him and his heirs & assigns forever
