Impr^d I give and bequeath to Cordale N^o Bynum a tract of land formerly belonging to James
Saxon lying and being in the County of N^o.ampton and state of N^o. Carolina containing
by estimation six hundred and ninety four acres to him and his heirs forever also one Negro man
Slave named Hugh if the said Bynum should die without issue lawfully begotten of his
body the said land and Slave Hugh to return to my estate and be equally divided between my
Children Elizabeth Norfleet John and Sarah Norfleet to them and their heirs forever
I give to my son John Norfleet all the residue of my land to him and his heirs forever
I give to my beloved wife Mary Norfleet the use of all my land for the benefit
of my Children Elizabeth Norfleet John Norfleet and Sarah Norfleet
during her life or widowhood or until my son John Norfleet shall come of age
at which time my said wife Mary shall have the use only of the plantation
where I now live containing fourteen hundred acres I do also give to my
wife Mary Norfleet during her life or widowhood all the residue of my
estate that I may die possessed of to make use of for the benefit of my
Children Elizabeth Norfleet John Norfleet and Sarah Norfleet
to them and their heirs forever at which time my will and
