of Virginia to be raised out of my estate the same to her heirs forever -

I Give and Bequeath unto my living wife Prudence Pope all my lands and
Plantations whomean know live and all my stock Cattle Hogs Swine sheep and
all my household Furniture and to say all my Estate be it of what nature or
kind soever I give it to her and her heirs forever -

Lastly I do make Constitute ordain and appoint my wife Prudence Pope
and friend Simon Harris my whole and sole Executors of this my Last
Will and Testament Revoking and annulling and making Void all
other Will or Wills by me heretofore made or declared In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 11th
Day 1772
