

Negroes belonging to me not mentioned to be Equally divided amongst my six eldest Children and the remainder of my Estate to be sold and equally divided amongst my younger Children and my Will and Desire is that my Children and their Negroes continue with her while they come to age or Marry except there shall be Marry them to her and out for three of the Children then give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally Parker and Negro Boy named Sam to her and her heirs forever then give and bequeath to John Matthew Parker and Negro named Page and Negro Girl named Jancy to him and his heirs forever.

I do here likewise constitute make ordain Brother Richard Parker and for some time and Randolph Newsum my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament in witness hereof I have set my hand and Seal
This 13th Day of June 1783

At a court held for the County of Southampton the 14th day of July 1789 This Will was presented in Court by Randolph Newsum the executor therein named Richard Parker thereupon refusing, and the said Will having been proved to the satisfaction of the Court to be wholly in the hand writing of the Testator is Ordered to be recorded and on the Motion of the said executor who made oath according to law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving Security whereupon &c.

In the name of God amen I Samuel Cobb of the County of Southampton being sick and weak of body but of sound and disposing mind and memory than by be to almighty God for the same but calling to mind the uncertainty of this life and knowing that it is appointed on e for all Men to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following
First give and bequeath unto my Son Matthew Cobb the land & plantation wherein he has resided and occupied containing by Compassion Forty Acres to him his heirs & assigns forever
I do here likewise constitute make ordain my Son Kinchen Cobb the land and plantation wherein I now live or so much thereof as is included in the following bound viz^t Begining at a black Gum an elbow Tree &c.
