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In the Name of God amen Giles Johnson of

the parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following Vizt I will that all my Debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged punctually by my executors hereafter named.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Stephen Johnson or his heirs and assigns forever all my lands and tenements together with the orchards and all other appurtenances thereunto belonging with my full and one shilling conditionally Vizt that he pay to my three Daughters Sarah Mary and Anne fifteen pounds a piece at the time of their arriving to twenty one year of Age or on their Marriage Day I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Anne Johnson the sum of ten pounds to be bestowed upon her in schooling to be done according to the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and if it may not be seemly with them to bestow it on her in schooling then to be bestowed on her as they shall think most proper

I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Mary one third part of my whole Estate during her Natural life or Widow hood and the remainder of my estate I give and bequeath unto my four Children namely Stephen Johnson, Sarah Johnson, Mary Johnson, and Anne Johnson to be equally divided between them, to them and their heirs forever Lastly I do constitute and appoint my trusty friends David Burrow and John Johnson executors to this my last Will and testament dated this nineteenth day of February in the year of our Lord 1789.
