In the Name of God amen I Giles Johnson of  
the parish of Nettleway and County of Southampton being of sound and disposing mind and  
memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following  
Right & Will that all my Debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged punctually by my executors  
hereafter named.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Stephen Johnson or his heirs and assigns forever all my lands and ten-  
ments together with the orchards and all other appurtenances therunto belonging with my Hull and one  
Horse conditionally to w<sup>t</sup> that he pay to my three Daughters Sarah, Mary and Penelope fifteen pounds  
a piece at the time of their arriving to Twenty one Years of Age or on their Marriage Day

I give and bequeath unto my Daughters Penelope Johnson the sum of ten pounds to be bestowed upon  
her in schooling to be done according to the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and if  
it may not be seemly with them to bestow it on her in Schooling then to be bestowed on her  
as they shall think most proper

I give and bequeath unto my living wife Mary one third part of my whole Estate during her  
natural life or Widower hood and the remainder of my estate I give and bequeath unto my  
four Children namely Stephen Johnson, Sarah Johnson, Mary Johnson, and Penelope Johnson  
to be equally divided between them, to them and their Heirs forever Lastly I do constitute  
and appoint my trusty friends David Birrman and John Johnson executors to this my last Will  
and testament dated this nineteenth day of February in the year of our Lord 1789.
