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In the name of God Amen the 21st day of August in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight I Robert Vick in the Province and County of Southampton being weak in Body but in perfect memory and senses than he be to god for it therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die I do make and ordain this my last will and Testament and first of all I Recommend my soul to the hand of god that gave it and for my Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be buried in decent like manner at the hands of my executors and as keeping such worldly estates as wherewith it hath been pleased god to bless me with I gave and dispose it in the manner and form as follows (to wit)

I give and bequeath to my son Jordan Vick my Land and Plantation where on I now live containing an a hundred Acres more or less at my decease to fall to the Highest bidder and sufficient to pay him self for all the Trouble and Caus that he is at with me while I live and the Remainder of it and all the Rest of my whole Estate goods and Chattles to be Equally Divided between all my Children I do leave my son Jordan Vick Executor to this my last Will and Testament wherof I have here unto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year above written
