

- I give to the said Derricks line to William Jacksons line thence along Jacksons
 line to allott hew Williams line thence on his line to the little swamp thence
 down the said swamp to the beginning also two Negroes Boys known by
 the names of Jacob and Kinchen to him and his heirs forever
 I give to my son Joel Edwards the plantation whereon he now lives containing
 two hundred acres more or less and bounded as follows (Viz) Beginning at a gum in the little swamp in adjacent Edwards line thence
 along the said to John Woods old line thence along that line to a
 light wood stake in Benjamin Whitfields line thence along the said line
 to Robert Fingersons line thence along his line to Ephraim Williams
 line thence on his line to Ephraim Williams line thence on his line to the
 little swamp thence down the various courses of the said swamp to the
 beginning also all my title to an entry of Land joining the for said Land
 also two Negroes Boys known by the names of Martin and Giles to him &
 his heirs forever
 I give to my son James Edwards the plantation he now has in possession
 containing two hundred and twenty Acres more or less and bounded as
 follows (Viz) Beginning at a gum in little swamp thence along a line of new
 marked trees to the Purcason then through the Purcason to the head line
 then along the head line to a pine corner in James Barnes line then along S.
 Barnes line to a white oak then along the said line to a pine thence along his
 line to Gordon Vicks line along the said Vicks line to the little swamp down
 the various courses of the said swamp to the beginning also one Negro Boy named
 Matthew and feather bed and furniture also one barrel more which I
 gave him and ten pounds cash to him & his heirs forever
 I give to my son Wm Edwards the neck of land lying between Swift Edwards
 and the lane on the plantation whereon now live I Cluding the fresh field
 containing twenty acres more or less also one Negro Boy called Tony and
 feather bed and furniture also a Horse that I gave him by the name of
 Demand and one Room of the house now live in the said room to receive
 at my death to him and his heirs forever
 I give to my Daughter Mary Whitfield two Negroes called and known by the
 names of Jones and Jack during her natural life and after her decease
 I give the said negroes to my Grandson George Whitfield to him and
 his heirs forever Likewise I give to my Daughter
 Mary Whitfield one feather bed and furniture which she
 now hath in possession to her & her heirs forever
 I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Ewert two Negroes known by the
 names of Babel and Japhy likewise one feather bed &
 furnitures which she now hath in possession to her
 heirs forever
