County Being Weak and in a low state of health but being in sound mind and  
Memory do make this my last Will and Testament in the manner following  
First of all I recommend my Soul into the hands of almighty God who gave it -  
hoping that at this general Resurrection to receive Pardon for all my Sins and  
my Body I commit to the ground from whence it was taken to be interred at the  
discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned

Item I give unto my beloved wife Ann Hines the use of all my Lands  
during her natural life and after her death to be sold and the money arising  
therefrom to be equally divided among my Children to wit Dolly C.  
Sarah and Elizabeth C. Hines to them and their heirs for ever

I also give unto my beloved wife Ann Hines for the Support of herself  
and Children Dolly C. Sarah and Elizabeth C. Hines during her  
widow hood the following Negroes to. Moses Tom Ned. Anthony  
Aggy. Cate Panny and Milly all the House hold and kitchen furniture  
and plantation Utensils my Bay Horse named Ball ten Choice  
of the Stock of my Cattle all my Stock of Hogs permitting them which  
are to fatten and all my stock of sheep one thousand two hundred pounds  
of fat park one stauld beef fifty barrels of corn and all my crop  
of pease Cotton and Potatoes all my old Bacon and fresh provided  
I have sold. Maury I then give her during her life the following  
Negroes. Aggy Panny and Milly and at her Marriage  
I desire that Moses, Tom, Ned. Anthony and Cate to be sold out  
and the Money arising therefrom to be appropriated to the  
use of the above mentioned Children and after her  
death my Will and desire is that all the above  
mentioned Negroes Moses, Tom, Ned. Anthony Aggy
