Mare called Parvin to him and his heirs &c
- Item I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Nicholas Williams my
Sorell Colt that is now at swift Creek to him &c
- Item I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Elias Williams my old
Mare called Flower to him &c
- Item I give and bequeath my Stocks of Cattle Hogs and Sheep to be
equally Divided betwixt all my Brothers and Sisters I likewise
give them all my Household Furniture of every kind to be
equally divided betwixt them
- Item I give and bequeath all my wearing apparel unto my
Brother John Williams
- Lastly I constitute and appoint my Friend Rice B Lince
to be my whole and sole Executor of this my last
Will and testament ratifying and confirming this
and no other to be my last will and testament
