In the name of God amen I Richard Kello of the County of Southampton being sick and weak but of disposing mind and Memory do make this writing as my last Will and Testament

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Locke my Negro Woman Leah with all her Children and their increase except my waiting Maidservant who in consideration of his faithful services I hereby Manumit and set free all the rest of my Estate whether real Personal or Mixed or whereever found I give devise and bequeath to my Son Samuel Kello and to his heirs forever and I appoint my Son Samuel Sole executor of this my last Will & Testament for the purposes of Carrying my intentions into effect which I have heretofore made him acquainted with I have thought proper to leave my Son Richard dependant on my executor for reasons which I have fully explained to him and I have perfect confidence that my Son Samuel will perform my intentions in such manner as I should have done myself In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 20<sup>th</sup> of May 1789
