

It is my will and desire that my Executors give no Security and that my Estate be not appraised

This Court held for the County of Southampton the 11th day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1790. This will was proved by the oaths of Thomas Larn and M<sup>rs</sup> Elizabeth Larn of the County of Southampton and ordered to be recorded And on the Motion of Samuel Wells the Executor therein named who made oath according to law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form.

In the name of God amen I Samuel Dewry being born and weak of body but of sound and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this as my last Will and Testament now king all former Wills by me made in manner and form following (to wit)

First

I give and bequeath unto my Son Samuel Dewry all that part of my Tract of Land wherein I now live that is bounded by the ahamosoc swamp William Crichtlow line a line of marked trees to another line of William Crichtlow bought of Joel Wood. by said Crichtlow line to the main road to Joel Woods line and by the said Woods line to the ahamosoc swamp supposed to contain two hundred acres more or less to him and his heirs for ever

Secondly

I give unto my Daughter Mary Satter Twenty Shillings

Thirdly

I give unto my Grand Daughter Katharine Johnson one feather Bed and Furniture on Chest and one Cow and calf to be delivered her when she arrives at the age of eighteen years but if she dies before Marriage or without lawful issue then I give the articles given her to my Daughter Ann Simons and her heirs for ever

Fourthly

I give unto my wife Elizabeth Dewry the use of all the remainder of my land and plantations wherein I now live also the use and labour of my Negroes Abel and Will also the use of all the remainder of my Estate of what nature or kind so ever during her widowhood

Fifthly

I give unto my Son James Dewry after the death or intermarriage of my wife my Negro Boy Will to him and his heirs for ever

Sixthly

I give unto my Son Humphrey Dewry after the death or intermarriage of my wife my Negro Boy Abel and to his heirs for ever

Seventhly

I give unto my Daughter Ann Simons after the death or intermarriage of my wife my team and all the Flax & Charcoal thereunto belonging also one linen wheel and one wainscot for her and her heirs for ever
