

367 on Consideration that he will settle and live on the same also Two thirds of my orchard and still and the other one third I give to my wife During her natural life But if my son John Thorpe refuses to settle on the said Land aforesaid I give the use thereof with the orchard and Still to my wife During her natural life or widowhood and after her Death my desire and my will is that all my said tract of Land may be sold to the highest Bidder and that the money arising from said Sale to be Divided as follows one half thereof to my Son John Thorpe if he lives after the death of my wife But if he should die before my wife my will is that this Son Aaron Thorpe should have the said above mentioned Money and the other two thirds of the money arising from said Sale of Land I will that it may be equally Divided Between my two Daughters to wit, to Elizabeth Harris and Sarah Briggs Thorpe also give to my said wife During her Natural life one Negro Man named Will and after her Decease to be equally divided Between my three Children above named also one negro Woman named Sarah and after her Decease to my Daughter Sarah Briggs Thorpe and if my Daughter Sarah Briggs Thorpe Should die without Lawfull Issue my will is that the said Negro Woman Sarah be equally Divided Between my other two aforesaid Children also I give to my wife five head of cattle to her choice fifteen head of Hogs to her choice fifteen Barrels of Corn two Ewes and Lambs to her choice and all the household and Kitchen Furniture I had when at my marriage with her also two Beds and Furniture during her natural life and after her decease to my Daughter Sarah Briggs Thorpe also the use of all the new feathers in the house to make a third bed till my said Daughter Marries or comes of age to herself it then to be given to my said Daughter Sarah Briggs Thorpe also I give to my wife my old Black Mare and my Gray mare also one Frying pan and one pott and six-table spoons.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Harris one mulatto Girl named Sarah ^{the younger than two years of age but not exceeding} one Boy named Redick During her natural life and after her Death to Mrs Harris two Jars if she has no other Issue and if she has no other Issue two Jars ^{if she has no other Issue} Redick to be equally Divided Between my Son John Thorpe and my Daughter Sarah Briggs Thorpe also give my Daughter Elizabeth Harris one Negro Boy named Tarrant and one Negro Woman named Venus During her natural life and if she has no other Issue after that
