

To cease to be divided Between Moses Harris's two sons and if Moses Harris's two sons should die without Lawfull heir then the said Portion and Venus to be Equally Divided Between my Son John Thorpe and my Daughter Sarah Briggs Thorpe I also give my Daughter Elizabeth Harris one Bed and Furniture -

Item I give and Bequeath to my son John Thorpe the Tract of Land lying in N^o Carolina whereon he now lives to him and his heirs forever -

I also give to my son John Thorpe one Negro man named Mark to him and his heirs forever also I lend my said son one Negro Man named Byrd During his natural life and after his decease to be Equally divided amongst his then surviving Children I also lend him one Negro Boy named Ben During his natural life and after his decease to be Equally divided amongst his then surviving Children also one Negro woman named Hannah During his natural life and after his decease to be equally divided Between his then surviving Children also a Negro Girl named Lucy which I bought of Benj^o Barham also one Bed and Furniture in Value Eight Pounds -

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Briggs Thorpe three Negroes - to wit Sam. Tam. and Genny to her and her heirs Lawfully Begotten of her body and if she dies without such lawfull heir then the said Negroes to be equally divided Between my son John Thorpe and my Daughter Elizabeth Harris I also give my Daughter Sarah Briggs Thorpe my Black Filley or woman Saddlars Bridle to her & her heirs forever also twelve pounds Current Money of Virginia -

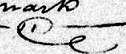
Item I give and bequeath unto Lord in Bass Son of Tabitha Bass one Negro Boy named Wallace to him and his heirs forever

Item And Lastly I do constitute and appoint my Son John Thorpe Lewis Thorpe and John Williamson to be the Executors of this my Last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this 7th Day of December 1786 -
