In the Name of God Amen the 26th day of July 1797

I Edward Britt Sen^r being weak in body but of sound mind and Memory calling to mind the Mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following (to wit) Principally and First of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it to be buried in a decent and Christianly Manner at the discretion of my Executors and as to what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give and dispose in manner and form following (to wit.)

Item I give to my Sons Edward Britt and Johnson Britt and to their heirs forever all my land and plantation wherein I now live to equally divided Between them

Item I give to my Daughter Patience Williams five Shillings

Item I give to my Son in law Arthur Holliman one Negro Boy called Peter to him and his heirs forever provided he account with my estate for twenty five pounds

Item I give to my Daughter Mary Allen one Negro Girl called Amaca, to her and her heirs forever provided she account with my estate for twenty five pounds

I give all the remainder of my Estate both of what nature or kind sever to be equally divided among my wife Sarah Britt and Children hereafter named vizt Sarah Summerell Edward Britt Junr Johnson Britt City Holliman Betsy Britt Mary Allen and my grandson Wiley Britt to them and their Heirs forever my will and desire is that if either of my aforesaid Children die in their non age or without lawfull issue of their Body the Survivors of them should inherit their part as aforesaid.

I lastly constitute and appoint my two Sons Edward Britt and Johnson Britt my whole and sole Executors of this my last will and testament revoking and making void all and every other former will herto fore by me made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and sealed my seal the day and Year first above written
