In the name of God Amen Edwin Gray of the County of Southamp-
ton do make and ordain this my last will and testament revoking all former wills by
me made in manner and form following -

First I give unto my Son Joseph four hundred acres of land more or less
bounded by the main road on our side on another side by Charles Briggs line to
where it joins the tract formerly purchased of Colthorpe thence along the
old dividing line between Colthorps tract to the Indian Branch thence down
that a small space to a black gum a corner tree formerly of the Nottoway
Indians thence the dividing line between the said Indians and Colthorps
untill it strikes the dividing line between the tract I now live on &
the said Colthorps from thence by a straight line to be made to a
white oak stump standing in the old road in the line between
John Colbs and my land thence along the said Colbs line to the road
afore said Note, thirty acres of this land I purchased of the
Nottoway Indians for the conveyance of which an act of
assembly has passed appointing trustees to convey the same to
me but not having obtained a Deed I desire the trustees may
convey the said thirty acres to my Son Joseph to whom
