white oak stump standing in the old road in the line between
John Cobb and my land thence along the said Cobb line to the road
aforesaid Note, thirty acres of this land I purchased of the
Nottoway Indians for the conveyance of which an act of
assembly has passed appointing trustees to convey the same to
me but not having obtained a Deed I desire the trustees may
convey the said thirty acres to my son Joseph to whom
