

So that is not given a way be equally divided amongst all my Children to them and their heirs forever and my desire is that my wife make void of any part of my Estate except Land or Negroes that who thinke will be to the advantage of the said estate and lastly I constitute to appoint my wife Mary Lewis my Son Debalon Lewis and my Son in Law Benjamin Butts my sole and Sole executors to this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made as I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this thirteenth day of August 1778.
