In the name of God amen I John Willens of the County of Sussex
amplon being the sick and weak yet of sound mind make this writing as for my
last will and testament revoking all other writings of this kind

I give and devise unto my son William Willens a certain tract or parcel of land containing
one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less lying on Round hill swamp on
Killos Mill pond to hold to my said son William and to his heirs and assigns forever
I also give my said son William one negro named Sam - one Cow and Calf two ewes and lambs
one crop ear ear and my Carpenters tools -

I give and devise to my son Benjamin Willens after the death of my wife Mary the
lands and plantation whereon I now dwell To hold to my said son Benjamin and to his
heirs and assigns forever I also give my said son Benjamin one negro named Esther with the
future increase of the said Slaves from the date hereof with the following articles one cow and
Calf two ewes and lambs one smoothe bore quiver an ox chain my shoe makers and coopers tools
and one feather Bed and furniture -

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca (now Rebecca Egan) a negro Ancy now in possession
of her husband Robert Egan with her future increase one cow and calf two ewes and lambs
the sum of eight pounds in gold or silver I hereby contain the gifts I may have made to
any of my Children of any personal Chattels and of which I have already possessed them

I give and devise unto well beloved wife for the term of her natural life the lands and
plantation whereon I now live with the appertinances thereto belonging all the
rest and residue of my estate not herein before particularly given consisting of Slaves
Stocks and personal Chattels of every whatever Species the same may be with the
future increase of my Slaves I give and bequeath the use to my said wife Mary for
the term of her natural life and after her death I give the same to wit the Slaves
and their increase as well as all other estate at her death to be equally divided between
my aforesaid Children or their legal representatives

I hereby appoint my two sons William and Benjamin Willens executors of this my last
Will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
Seal this sixteenth day of July in the year one thousand seven hundred and eighty
four Signed Sealed published and declared
by the said John Willens as and for
his last will and testament in presence of
